PRAYER BREAKFAST AT THE UNITED NATIONS

September 18 — what a day it was! As so often, I have to pinch myself as I consider this incredible platform that we have to bring the truth and love of Christ to world leaders. Diplomats from 100 different countries gathered together that morning!

Despite the heavy wind and rain, we had a full house. It was held in a tent this year, due to renovations taking place in the UN building. The violent wind brought to mind that I had emailed to ask for prayer for a "fresh wind of the Holy Spirit to sweep across the UN". It was indeed holy ground!

The room was elegantly decorated and a string quartet played in the background as we welcomed the ambassadors and diplomats. The diplomats enjoyed mingling together so much so, it was difficult to get them seated at the tables before the program could begin!

The program included a moderator, Scripture readings, and prayers offered by various ambassadors. Our soloist sang the Lord's prayer with such power, depth, and conviction, it was truly to God's glory. **Ravi Zacharias** (one of the world's foremost Biblical apologists) brought a gracious and interesting message. He clearly presented Jesus. He spoke about evil, injustice, and violence; and ended with an incredible thought: "either we accept the sacrifice of the Son of God or we will continue to sacrifice our sons on the battlefields". One comment we received read, "I was deeply moved by Dr. Zacharias' remarks as his clarity of mind and humility touched my heart. Many thanks." Though the breakfast ran slightly overtime, everyone sat attentively as Ravi concluded his remarks. On comment cards, diplomats used words like "powerful", "thought-provoking", "riveting", "profound", and "moving" to describe the message.

Afterwards, many of the attendees requested Bibles, DVDs of the JESUS film in their home language, or transcripts of Ravi's talk.

Over the next weeks, Christian Embassy staff will be visiting the diplomats' offices, delivering the requested materials and seeking to develop deeper relationships. We will endeavor to follow up with those who requested items and make further conversation, using Ravi's message to springboard into the gospel.

In the future, as you hear news about speeches and resolutions taking place at the UN, know that many of the ambassadors and diplomats who attended this breakfast were influenced by Ravi's speech. Pray that what they heard would resound in their hearts and that the truth of needing to accept the sacrifice of God's Son will become clearer and make a profound influence in their lives and work at the UN.

IRAN — PROCLAIMING LIBERTY TO THE CAPTIVE!



The official name of this country is <u>The Islamic</u> <u>Republic of Iran</u>. It is also called <u>Persia</u>, as it is home to one of the world's oldest civilizations; the Persian people, known for their rich history and culture. Since



1979, however, the country became an *Islamic republic* with a theocratic government that instituted *Shar'ia Law* which the authorities strictly enforce. That means that the government has endeavored to take full control over the popula-

tion of 75 million, demanding they submit to the Koran and Allah in all matters of life and conduct. Owning a Bible is punished by imprisonment, evangelizing is a serious crime, and converting from Islam to Christianity is punishable by death.

In spite of such drastic measures, the number of Iranian Muslims coming to Christ is accelerating—from app. 200 forty years ago, to close to 400,000 today (@Open Doors). An Iranian friend told me that, presently in Iran, there are app. 1,000 Muslims who daily embrace the Christian faith. They meet in secret in each other's homes out of sight from the government. In one city, there are more than 300 house churches. Due to the severe economic embargo imposed on the country by the world leaders, the population is lacking in the most basic needs, and sickness and malnutrition are widespread. Some predict that, if there is no change of course, Iran will shortly suffer a complete economic collapse. The fear is that, if pushed to the wall, the leaders will deploy a nuclear weapon against their arch enemy, Israel.

The above scenario is very much like the Soviet Union just before the collapse of Communism. God's hand moved over those nations and revealed Himself to hundreds of thousands of young atheists hungry for truth and the reality of a living God! We believe that God is now visiting the Iranian people with His Spirit and calling those who are hungry to fellowship with Him! People around the world are interceding and serving them with the love of Jesus. Where evil abounds, grace abounds more!

We have been and are presently actively partnering with a number of individuals and groups who are doing significant ministry to the Iranian people — from Kazakhstan to the Caucasus, from Norway to the Netherlands, from Great Britain to the United States. In this issue, I am highlighting significant testimonies from two of them:

Yousef Nadarkhani, a Muslim turned Pastor after his conversion from Islam to the Christian faith. On Sep 8, he was released from a three year imprisonment and his death penalty verdict was overturned. This was due to faithful believers who prayed and acted on his behalf! I have enclosed his thank you letter to the Body of Christ.

FROM R.K.'S CORNER

Perhaps the gravest, under-publicized atrocity in the world is the persecution of Christians. A comprehensive study last year found that Christians are persecuted in 131 out of 195 countries in the world containing 70 percent of the world's population. The best estimates are that about 200 million Christians live in communities where they are suffering, and close to 150,000 Christians a year are murdered for their faith.

In addition to North Korea, China, and Cuba, the main perpetrators live in Islamic countries in which **Shar'ia Law** is established by their governments. Unlike in the past, today there is no major outcry in the West against these gross human rights violations. The reason is that the public in general is unaware of the scale and barbarity of this persecution as it is rarely publicized by the mostly atheistic, passive, and indifferent Western media and governments.

The good news behind the news is that, when the Christian church is persecuted, it grows! Several of our friends and partners serve the Lord among Muslims. In this issue, I am highlighting a testimony from Iran and from another who works among Muslim peoples. Each of them asks for prayer as they continue to reach out to the unsaved with the love and care of Jesus. Please mark your donations Iranian Workers.
