The phone rang, "Hi, this is Steve. We have been given a car to use, so we will come to see you for a few days"... direct, simple and practical... the hallmark of Stephen (Steven) and Sophia Schmalz' approach to life! My Steve and I were delighted finally, we would finally meet this precious Dutch/ American couple with whom we have partnered for nearly 12 years in serving indigenous pastors in the Republic of Georgia. We knew them by voice and written communication, but we had never met in person! Every four years, Steve and Sophia return to the States and Holland from Tbilisi, Georgia's main capital, for a few months of sabbatical to visit family and friends and get some R/R. This was good timing!

We offered them the usual vacation pleasures for weary missionaries — what about a couple of days on the beach... or a trip to one of Orlando's many theme parks... perhaps some money to spend at the large discount mall up the road? They declined. "We have all the clothes we need — stopped by a few thrift stores on the way down", said Sophia (she is well dresses, by the way).

What would they like to do? "Just spend time with you — we like to do practical things for people we visit — is there anything I can do for you?" Steve asked, turning to my husband. So, while trimming trees and fixing odds and ends in our home, the short Steve took the tall Steve on a journey into the hearts of the Georgian people, sharing stories of faith and courage, and testimonies of God's miraculous intervention of love and care toward them and the believers there. Sophia and I did what women do... we shared our hearts with one another! We all talked a lot, laughed lot, ate a lot... and prayed! They transmitted to us a fresh love for the Georgia people!

On the last day of their visit, Steve said, "Now, we've got to go to the Mall!" I was thrilled — finally something for them! Both Steve and Sophia put on T-shirts with the letters JESUS printed in large letters across the front. They then walked the hallways of the Mall, sharing the Gospel with anyone they met... and they were many! They returned empty-handed with things, but hearts full of joy and concern for the people they had met. Steve and Sophia came to us as partners and missionaries — but we left one another as friends!

The reason I detail this visit a bit, is that their stay showed who they really are — immediate, warm, servant-hearted, serious in their relationship with the Lord while exuding the radiance of God's presence, always ready to share their faith and resources with others with unwavering integrity while identifying with the people they serve — two ordinary people called together by God to do extraordinary things!

Sophia an I are only two people. What can two people do in a country of about 5 million? Very much, is the answer. Without the Body of Christ, we're nothing but two people. With the Body of Christ, we have been able to move mountains in people's lives!
