3. **Mission Wires.** Disbursements classified as Mission Wires represent funds transferred directly to ministry partners, field workers, and approved projects in the indicated regions.

4. **Donor Privacy.** Individual donor names and identifying information have been omitted from this public summary in accordance with the organization's privacy policy.

5. **No Audit Opinion.** This statement has not been subject to an independent audit. It is presented solely for the purpose of donor transparency and accountability.
